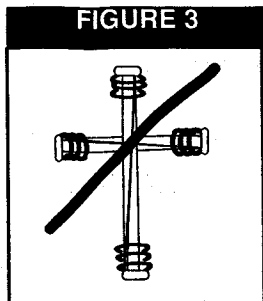
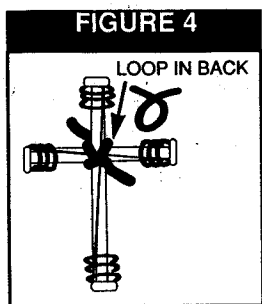


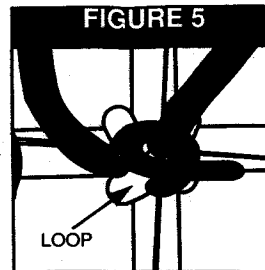
- 6 Cut another piece of wire 10" long. Place the wire's center on the intersection of the nails (see figure 3).



- 7 Tightly wrap the wire around both sets of nails, until you have two 1/2" tails of wire left. Take the two tails and form a loop (see figure 4).



- 8 Cut one yard of the black cord. Thread the cord through the loop on the back of the necklace (see figure 5). Take both ends of the cord and tie them together.



MORE IDEAS: Try textured paints for different looks. Make a pin or barrette out of your cross. Take black paint brush it on the cross and wipe off for an antique look.

HELPFUL HINT: If you are unable to wrap the wire tight enough to hold the two sections of the cross together put a spot of white glue between the two sections and let dry.
